Utah animal rights activist Jordan Halliday was charged with felony contempt of court for refusing to testify before a grand jury. This charge carries no maximum penalty. On July 27, 2010, Jordan plead guilty to one count of felony contempt. His sentencing was November 3, 2010. He received a sentence of 10 months in prison, to start in January 2011.

GRAND JURIES: "Because of their broad subpoena powers and secretive nature, grand juries have been used by the government to gather information on political movements and to disrupt those movements by causing fear and mistrust... Those called before the grand jury may be compelled to answer any question, even those relating to lawful personal and political activities." (<http://grandjuryresistance.org>)

The ANIMAL LIBERATION FRONT (ALF) "carries out direct action against animal abuse in the form of rescuing animals and causing financial loss to animal exploiters, usually through the damage and destruction of property. The ALF's short-term aim is to save as many animals as possible and directly disrupt the practice of animal abuse. Their long term aim is to end all animal suffering by forcing animal abuse companies out of business. It is a nonviolent campaign, activists taking all precautions not to harm any animal (human or otherwise)." (www.animalliberationfront.com)

The EARTH LIBERATION FRONT (ELF) "is an international, underground movement consisting of autonomous groups of people who carry out direct action in defense of the planet while taking every precaution against harming any animal human or non-human." (www.earthliberationfront.org)

"THE BLACK PANTHER PARTY (BPP) was a progressive political organization that stood in the vanguard of the most powerful movement for social change in America since the Revolution of 1776 and the Civil War...It is the sole black organization in the entire history of black struggle against slavery and oppression in the United States that was armed and promoted a revolutionary agenda, and it represents the last great thrust by the mass of black people for equality, justice and freedom." The BLACK LIBERATION ARMY (BLA) was an underground, black nationalist-Marxist militant organization that operated in the United States from 1971 to 1981. Composed largely of former Black Panthers (BPP), the organization's program was one of "armed struggle" and its stated goal was to "take up arms for the liberation and self-determination of black people in the United States."
