Tell California to Make PacifiCorp take responsibility for their Toxic Klamath Dams.

In 2006 Warren Buffett's PacifiCorp filed to start the process of obtaining a needed Clean Water Act permit for their dams on the Klamath River. This permit is the last step in the Federal Energy Reg-

ulatory Commission's (FERC) relicensing process for the Klamath Dams, which only happens every 50 years.

When these dams were originally permitted there were no laws such as the Clean Water Act or Endangered Species Act. Therefore these antiquated dams have no fish passage, release toxic algae, and warm water that is lethal to salmon. PacifiCorp admits that keeping these toxic dams would cost much more than dam removal. However, every year PacifiCorp stalls dam regulation they make millions to the Klamath's detriment. Current time lines associated with the Klamath Basin Restoration Agreement (KBRA) could allow PacifiCorp to stall for 8 more years!
