

STOP AC TRANSIT FARE HIKE

Recently bus drivers, mechanics, service and clerical workers in ATU Local 192 resoundingly rejected another takeaway contract from our employer, AC Transit. Like everyone in the bay area, we are fighting for a decent wage. We have not had a raise since 2000! We also fight for better running times, bathroom breaks, and better safety. All of these things mean improved service for riders and healthier workers. We also know that AC transit plans to raise fares, hitting young people, seniors, and the disabled the hardest. We stand with riders against fare increases as we ask riders to stand in solidarity with us as we work towards a better contract.

AC Transit has cut bus services in recent years while also raising fares. Just as workers are forced to work more for lower pay and under poor conditions, so to must riders pay more and get less.

The bosses want to raise cash fares another 15¢ to \$2.25 and, worst of all, **raise the 31-day pass for youth, seniors, and the disabled from \$20 to \$26.50.**

We must stand together! Join the protest on August 28th and take the fight to AC Transit's doorstep!
