

Black Mesa Caravan 2008 Projects Needs List

- Chainsaws!!
- Wood & tools to chop wood.
- Building materials. Lumber, fencing, roofing materials, tar paper, nails, screws, etc.
- Funds for building materials.
- Vehicles to donate to families. Vehicles that are able to drive on rough terrain. Trucks are the best but not necessary.
- Tools for chopping wood and digging: Shovels, hoes, axes, mauls, saws, etc.
- Hammers, hand saws, boxes of screws, nails, & chalking.
- Portable generators, chain saws, work gloves.
- Portable stove / propane tanks, large pots to use during the caravan.
- Food.
- Water barrels, fittings, pumps.
- Solar panels, generators, wind turbines.
- Anyone who is self sufficient, has an open heart, and with a
 willingness to work! Anyone who is skilled in carpentry, permaculture, vehicular repairs, bodyworkers, electrical, etc. please
 notifiy coordinators. Consider driving your vehicle, we are short
 of vehicles heading to the caravan.
- A large tent or teepee that can have a fire inside to keep us warm!
- Medicinal herbs. (For stress, colds & flus, digestion, altitude sickness, & external salves & rubs)
- Blankets
- chainsaw parts Stihl MS 170: chain, oil cap,
- bar/chain oil, 1982 VW Jetta manual, educational books for 13 yr old son and for adults
- Natural medicines: liniments and salves for bad backs, arthritis, arnica, aloe vera.
- Solar parts (batteries)

A caravan of work crews from across the US will be traveling to Black Mesa, Arizona, the sacred ancestral homelands of the Dine' and Hopi peoples, who are resisting massive coal-mining expansion plans and forced relocation laws.

A Santa Cruz contingent will be joining the caravan this year to deliver supplies and assist with on-land projects.

Supplies dropped off at the Santa Cruz benefit event will join us in the journey to Black Mesa.
