

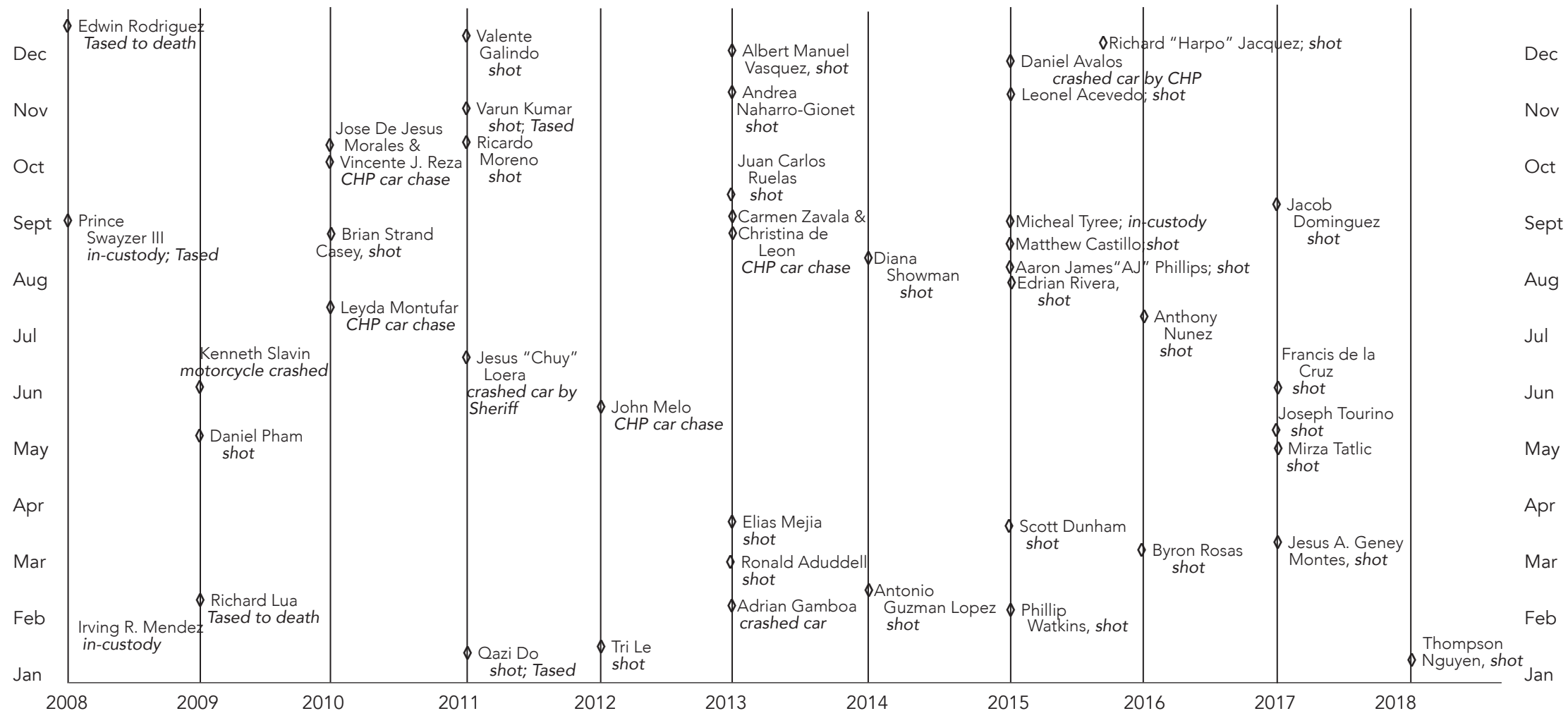

This timeline is based on convivial research and numerous investigative and documentation projects, often archived through public contestations following an act of state violence and including timelines collectively generated as part of the rolling People's Movement Assembly (PMA) in 2014 and a community timeline workshop with families from San Jose, Stockton, Hayward, and San Francisco in March of 2018. Sources include the work of families and the organized San Jose community. We also draw on the documentation efforts of D. Brian Burghart's Fatal Encounters, Stolen Lives Project, and various local projects and sources, including Justice for Josiah. -Center for Convivial Research and Autonomy (CCRA), 12 May 2018.

Strategies & Major Events

1994-2010: Violent Crimes Enforcement Team (VCET) in operation aimed at reducing youth violence. VCET emerged from the Mayor's Gang Prevention Task Force (begun 1991).

2011 Operation Community Shield: SJPD collaboration with ICE to deport "gang" members.

2013 San Jose Violence Reduction Plan (VCRP) established as a long term "gang" suppression strategy.

SJPD secretly acquires a drone with Homeland Security Funds.

2015 Operation William Street formed as collaborative effort between SJPD & SJSUPD

2016 CATO awards SWAT Team of the year to SJPD MERGE Unit
