# The San Francisco Frozen Film Festival Is Back In-person For Its 17<sup>th</sup> Year Featuring an Exciting New Outdoor Film Venue in San Francisco!

*San Francisco, CA*, June 7, 2023. Known for its nearly two-decade celebration of San Francisco and International Film, the local staple of the SF Art community returns in person for their annual summer celebration of film. Shouting literally from the rooftops downtown (where films will literally screen on top of buildings and at their opening night party) the 17<sup>th</sup> Annual San Francisco Frozen Film Festival (SFFFF) runs from July 12<sup>th</sup> to the 16<sup>th</sup>.

Previously awarded *Top 25 Coolest Film Festivals in the World* by Moviemaker Magazine, audiences can celebrate the acclaimed programs lounging comfortably in this year's exciting new outdoor film venue, *The Cut Outdoor Cinema*! This rare rooftop outdoor theater is brought to the public by SFFFF2023 in partnership with Noise Pop, a Bay Area event producer who has been championing independent music and culture since 1993.

The Frozen Film Festival (which predates Disney's film) showcases one of the best annual international film programs to come to SF annually. With the closure of so many local partners (including Piano Fight) please come and support the local filmmakers as they return in person in a safe-outdoor live venue. In addition to bringing the best selection of new film traveling the global film festival circuit SFFFF2023 showcases over 50 local Bay Area films and filmmakers as part of the film festival's nonprofit programming mission.

SFFFF2023 brings an epic collection of films from over 50 countries, including inspiring feature and short documentary films, mind-bending experimental films, award-winning animation program, comedy shorts, LGBTQ+ films, and an amazing collection of films made and produced in the Bay Area by students and local artists, many will be attending for live audience talks. Including the highly anticipated declassified UFO footage documentary *Phoenix Incident* that other galaxies don't want you to see, SFFFF2023 has it all!

Our award winning 25\$ festival pass that gets you into every film plus the opening night party now allows you to screen an additional 100 films online! Come mingle with local filmmakers and check out Tony Hawk in the skate and surf feature film, *Humanity Stoked*

before topping it off with a night of animation and some international short documentary films and comedic films.

## A few festival program highlights:

**Stoker Machine,** an award-winning animated surf documentary and **Sports Fanatics**, a documentary that explores the physical, mental, and social effects of being a sports fanatic, and their impact on sports filmed in the San Francisco Bay Area; or, **Protecting the River Krupa**, an exploration of Europe's waterways and the countries that are rallying to protect the continent's last free-flowing rivers—before it's too late. All playing part of the Short Documentary Film Collection.

Las Muralistas: Our Walls, Our Stories a 25-minute documentary in partnership with SFMOMA featuring women muralists whose works cover the walls of San Francisco's Mission District. Double Cultura, a story of a twelve year who takes on the overwhelming responsibility of being her immigrant mothers' translator. Both are playing with ten other short films as part of the 2023 Bay Area Local Film Program.

**Look Like You**: a story of overcoming challenge and growing up as a queer outcast, and **Boifriend**, a story of a gay cis woman's father who is surprisingly happy when she brings her transmasc boyfriend home. Both play with other amazing films part of the LGBTQ+ Themed Short Program.

*Hating Beckett* A couple's post-theater dinner date turns confrontational to the point of disclosed trauma, bitter recriminations and hurled bread rolls, and *CUCKOO!* an Absurd comedy about a lonely man who lives inside a cuckoo clock. Both play with other humorous films part of the 2023 Comedic Short Films collection.

Forgotten Fountains, an experimental documentary that harnesses Super 8mm and found 16mm footage to explore drinking fountains as a lens on the broader infrastructure crisis in the United States, and, Safe Passage (for Sheila), a look at living alone during the pandemic and challenging the femme fatale stereotype. The two and thirteen other thought provoking and compelling art films play part of the Experimental Short Film & Visual Art program.

SFFFF2023's Bay Area Local + Student Film in partnership with Bay Area Video Coalition is one of the annual program highlights audiences adore focusing on bringing amazing local stories to life from the lens of the student filmmakers of tomorrow.

Do not miss your chance to see these rare collections of films, filmmaker Q & A's, and in-person outdoor events. SFFFF2023 is open to all ages and runs July 12th through July 16th. All festival passes are available for \$25.00 and include access to the opening night party featuring multiple local live music acts and film on July 12th, and access to every individual SFFFF film event at The Cut through July 16th.
