### Riot Cops Destroy UCSC's Gaza Solidarity Encampment and Arrest Dozens of Students

Shortly after midnight on May 31, riot cops from multiple agencies descended on UC Santa Cruz in order to remove the Gaza Solidarity Encampment established by Students for Justice in Palestine. For the first hour of the police presence, officers cordoned off the area surrounding the encampment. Students then grouped closely together and locked arms near a blockaid they created on May 28 to prevent traffic from entering the main entrance to campus. Throughout the evening and into the morning there were hundreds of riot cops on campus.

Shortly after 1 am, police moved in and began destroying the tents in the encampment. Eventually they kettled the students, and then began a slow, methodical process of arresting people. Dozens of students had their wrists fastened with zip-ties so they could be taken to the Santa Cruz main jail. They were transported in busses and vans provided by outside agencies, such as the Santa Cruz Police Department and the Santa Clara County Sheriff's Office.

UCSC students first established the Gaza Solidarity Encampment on May 1 at Quarry Plaza, but then moved its location next to the Barn Theater on May 20, the day the UAW 4811 strike picket line began.

One of the dominant messages students repeatedly communicated to the riot police was that they would be back to continue their demonstrations.

By 9 am, police had pushed students across High Street and away from the main entrance of campus, keeping them there as workers removed the destroyed materials that had once been the encampment.



### A Call for a Week of Autonomous Action e3 an End to the Accelerated Siege on Gaza

### Friday June 14th - Wednesday June 19th

Hurry comrade! The acceleration of anti-Palestinian genocide and the Israeli-Zionist war of annihilation against our Palestinian siblings must be put to stop NOW. Immediately. Not one more day. As students, alumni, loving educators, and beloved community who are negatively affected by the military+prison+university-schooling industrial complex, it is an urgent and historic imperative that we take a fucking stand. Not next week, not next months not next lifetime. But now.

We have the numbers and the courage. And we have the resilience to outlast their war of attrition. For the past two months there has been a decentralized, horizontal, and widespread insurgency growing on U.S. college campuses, calling to #Escalate revolutionary action in support of Palestine. The current trajectory of this movement is doomed without a reassessment of the stakes and strategies we are currently using.

### NO MORE GRADUALISM IN THE FACE OF GENOCIDE.

A new phase of the #Escalate movement on college campuses has begun. With Berkeley lighting the way. We are calling this **OPERATION CAMPUS FLOOD**. This initiative is an open invite for all who are sick of it this, to join in <u>displacing the displacers</u>. From the outside in and the inside out, we need to raze the settler-plantation academy that provides training, labor, capital, and a steady stream of propaganda and knowledge production for the Israel-Zionist entity. Are we tired yet of asking for permission for the colleges to divest the occupation of Palestine? All you need is three people and some hammers and ATTACK THE GLASS.

What if we popped the locks of the libraries and liberate the books, computers, and printers? Think of all the flyers we could print to further end this genocide. Can we expropriate this infinite supply of material wealth and resources housed in campus supply buildings? We can seize buildings. We can take up space massively with community support. We can even turn UC Berkeley Sproul plaza into the New People's Park. Just start your fire on a seperate very far corner of the campus. It is a very big space. This is Ohlone and Miwok land, and the schools are also the front-lines of gentrifyer real-estate development in every city. In Berkeley, for instance, the University is 100% the sole responsible party in the desecration of People's Park and forced removal of the community who lived there, a community that found refuge from capitalism. They did this to build more student housing. Just like the displacement of Gaza, the houseless community in People's Park was removed by the Zionists/Amerikkkans.

We can take over the cafeterias and feed the hungry. On every campus. We can fulfil the demands of the 1968 student movement to liberate the campuses and open them up to the communities around them. We can use our imaginations if we all act together, decentralized, horizontally, and with the shared principles of destroying the campuses until the US withdraws its support for the Israeli-Zionist scum. We can seize the dorm buildings and house the houses. Or, if taking space gets us arrested in nearly every new encampment or demo (exposing us also to massive state surveillance and network mapping) then is direct attack at the point of production on these campuses not the only viable option that remains?

Put otherwise, if these methods are not viable options at your local campus, then there are other options, much more stealth, quiet, and cost effective for us (and massively debilitating to them). For example, we could simply TORCH the buildings and artificial landscapes that colonize the land these universities occupy.

Fire is quiet. Fire is quick and easy. And it only takes on spark. These these are already tinderboxes, and there are examples of targets and methods abundant. 2 parts gasoline, 1 part oil in a beer bottle does the trick. Or just buckets of gasoline.

Some reasons to destroy the Amerikkkan/Zionist college campuses next week:

- 1) U.S. college campuses produce the middle managers of global capitalism, white supremacy, antiBlackness, and cis-heteropatriarchy.
- 2) The administrators are complicit completely in this current gratuitous siege.
- 3) College campuses in the in the core of Amerikkkan settler-empire are sites of intensive discipline into pure docility, a trained docility that enables the projects of genocide against Palestine.

4) College campuses in the Bay Area also are facilitators of an even more normalized genocide of Black, Indigenous, migrant and refugee communities here.

Do we fully understand the correlation between the means we choose and the ends we desire? Our words and deeds? What we think in relation to what we do? Are we honestly confronting the disconnect between our dreams and the reality of the genocide situation that Palestine—as well as Black/Native/poor/queer/trans/disabled people here—are confronted by? We owe it to the oppressed, enslaved, and colonized peoples of the Bay Area to actualize social war here.

The U.S. state and the Zionist entity are the same apparatus ya'll. Amerikkka has been on the ground heavily in occupied Palestine, fighting with the IOF (Israel Occupation Forces) since October 10th. This is because they are mutually-constituting settler nations that cannot exist without the institution of the settler academy. Not only do some of these college campuses (such as UC Berkeley and Stanford) literally design and create the very ingredients of genociders technology and statecraft that are exported to the Israeli-Zionist entity, and vis-versa, they are also centers of Zionist and Amerikkkan white supremacist knowledge production.

### A local example of how Operation Campus Flood has unfolded in one Bay Area city:

At UC Berkeley campus, for instance, there have been three successive arson attacks within a three weeks span, in retaliation against the UC system for their allowance of police attacks on vulnerable student demonstrators. There has also been a mass robbing of a building. This has been the content of Round 2 of the UCB #Escalate struggle. Round I entailed the first encampment, which lasted several weeks and provided a space of care for people of all walks of life. It was a beautiful spiritual atmosphere in the encampment. With prayers, food distro, and peer-topeer lessons in community accountability and addressing conflict in movements. The liberals in the camp fucked it up. But we also can't blame them. They are just politically confused, and want the end of genocide also. We need to stand together, and show people that massive community support in the form of materially disruptive direct action against the campuses can force an abrupt decision to be made by the colonizers settler states. The encampment, in round 1, could have actually pressured the UC administration for greater (more radical) demands if people simply stuck around longer to defend it from fascists/zionists and liberals. But it's all good. Because Round I also entailed the takeover of a building, Hines House, which unfortunately resulted in the mass arrest of several people.

Yet the building takeover was special and incredibly important. The fact that people seized a building for that long should be celebrated and studied. We can do that to several building all at once, one every campus. There is enough of us. The people outnumber the police 1000 to 1.

Round 2 of the UC Berkeley struggle to end the genocide, began with a targeted break in and theft of thousands of dollars of materials from a building, and a cop car set ablaze a few days later as retaliation against UCPD on the first day of Pride. The Bay Area has set it off Sylvia Rivera style. A few days after that someone lit a hill in the back of the campus on fire. And last night, someone firebombed the backside of a building on the northside of the campus. These actions, if multiplied and done en mass can create a decisive rupture condition, which has the potential to force the divestment of Bay Area college systems from ties to not only Israel the settler state, but ties with U.S. weapons manufacturers involved in militarization across the world. If they refuse, we should simply burn their shit down. Now, this is just one example. Every campus in the Bay Area is a different scenario, but each can be taken over (and resources redistributed) or destroyed if people just show out.

This weekend of autonomous insurgent action against the colonizer campuses invites not only students to attack, but also (and the most importantly) the communities around them who are affected by their colonizer-gentrifying-displacement tactics. It is important that we show out in mass numbers so we can successfully end this genocide.

There is no time left. Thousands and thousands of people are being murdered daily. What are we doing? If we're even around in 20 years, imagine the feeling in your gut when you learned that you could stop this, but chose to do nothing?

People truly underestimate how connected the U.S. settler state and the Israeli-Zionist entity is. If we actualize the social war against Zionism HERE, now, we have the greatest chance of ending the massacres that flit across your timeline and continue to not only kill our spirits (as it feels like we can do "nothing") but also demoralize us. What people underestimate is not only the military connections, but in fact, the police state connections. The police the bludgeon you are protest demonstrations are the (literal) same apparatus that is oppressing Palestine and attacking South Lebanon as well. When people are in the streets they must be prepared to DEFEND themselves and everyone around them. Ideally, we should promote actions that don't result in mass arrests.

We need to defend revolt instead of letting liberals who hate uprisings demonize militant protest. Resisters instead should experiment with group-based and lonewolf attacks on the key infrastructure (buildings, mainframes, technology) of the Universities and their built landscape. Trees, bushes, and dried grass makes quiet and quick attacks easy.

Every action should speak for itself as opposed to people sharing communiques and posting claims. We need to take a stand NOW. Or else more people will continue to be slaughtered by the Israel occupier state. We should make the newsreel instead of letting the mainstream and "alternative" social media algorithms shape our consciousness and points of entry for action.

Autonomy means there is no leadership or no vanguard group leading these actions. Autonomy means that people are free to do whatever they feel is necessary to force the UC system, CSU system, Community College system, and private college campuses to divest from Israeli-Zionist settler entity that is currently genociding our Palestinian siblings.

## How to Have a Night to Forget

#### **Preparing for Fun**

- Leave your phone out of this. Not just turned off.
   It should not be in the vicinity of, or used in
   conversations, planning, or the fun itself. *Your phone is an informant* that snitches on you using
   gps data, cell data, search history, potentially your
   microphone and camera, your contacts, and
   schedule.
- Only use TAILS USB or Qubes-Whonix for researching location, directions, or anything else.
- Use cash or theft to acquire anything you need, and don't acquire it near your house or the site of the fun.
- openstreetmap and wikimapia are online map resources to help plan your route, though not a replacement for scoping out the area in person.
- Look for the safest entrance route and exit route, prioritizing paths without cameras, identify several options. Scout the place ahead of time. Be cautious when scouting - if it looks like you're obviously casing the joint shortly before something happens there it could make you a suspect. Wear an outfit that makes you unidentifiable and get rid of the clothing after.
- After seeing the place, finding the cameras and blind-spots, identifying an entrance and exit, and where you want to change clothing, you can begin dreaming up the fun you will have there.

### Ways to get there

- Cars: Are identifying. From license plates, and specific makes, models, years, colors, to body damage, scratches, and the windows that could show you inside.
  - Avoiding cameras and staying reasonably far away from the vicinity of the fun is one option. Some have claimed they have parked out of sight, had fun, and drove away. Some have claimed they stole another car's plates. Some claimed to be dropped off and picked up. The largest risks are the car being seen by bystanders who think you are out of place and remember the car or call the police, and surveillance cameras, ring cameras, highway cameras, there's literally cameras EVERYWHERE these days, depending on if you're in a rural or urban environment.
- Bikes: Bicycles can't be easily tracked, yet everything could be identifiable – bar tape, lights, tire tread, handlebars, just the shape or height of the bike. Using a bike that is not your own resolves this issue.
- Public Transit: has surveillance cameras, they can piece together where you get on/off. Pay in cash, or don't pay at all.

### Considering Cameras and Eye Witnesses

- Security cameras can track license plates using Automatic License Plate Recognition.
- If there are security guards, decide if you can maneuver around them, and have a plan for if they notice you.
- If there are no CCTV cameras in an area, Law Enforcement will gather nearby home security footage and car cameras to use as evidence.
- Every witness and camera is a potential snitch. Dressing properly should prevent them from being able to identify you. If someone witnesses you having fun they could confront you or call the police. This is best avoided. If someone follows you, make them stop.

#### **Dress for success**

**Cover every inch of your body** to minimize the spread of DNA, and conceal your identity.

### GET RID OF YOUR CLOTHING AFTERWARDS

- Unidentifiable yet "normal" clothing is possible
  with some thrifted baggy clothing. You might
  prefer this if you expect to be in public view for
  long periods. You can wear shoes you've never
  worn before and plan to dispose of after instead of
  socks over your shoes.
- Socks over your shoes can't avoid footprints, but it can hide the tread of your shoe, making it less identifiable.
- Painters or asbestos/mold suits can be used and are cheap, but they also stand out.
- Dress in this order covid mask/cap → gloves → get dressed → dispose of gloves → 2nd set of rubber or mechanics gloves

#### **How To Disappear Completely**

1 Follow Your Entrance Plan

2 Change clothing where you decided

3 Have Fun

4 Change Clothing

5 Follow Your Exit Plan

6 Burn or dispose of **EVERYTHING** used in the fun night.

Tools can be later used as evidence.

Gasoline, glass bottles, burned oil and rags are easily acquired. Also other materials with which one can attack the system and its cops can be easily found. For us, all means that are in accordance with the ends are weapons that can be directed against power. Maybe some are more destructive than others, but no any means gets ideological overrating over another.

#### FOR ANIMALS OF THE NIGHT

- 1. To significantly limit leaving casual traces, it is necessary to wear new gloves, a face mask, a hair net or, even better, closed headgear and washed clothes with long sleeves and pant legs. The face mask should prevent aerosolized saliva. Using a new full-body suit, is better than clothing because it is non-permeable. These are also used by police forensics teams to prevent DNA contamination.
- What plays right into the hand of police is the fact that clothing fibers, which have been the focus of forensics all over the planet for decades, almost always yield usable DNA of the person wearing the clothes.

3. Places where people have peed can also be of interest to investigators. Cigarette butts or saliva residue on stamps and envelopes are of legendary popularity.

- 4. Many movies depict people wiping away fingerprints. It is incomparably more difficult to get rid of DNA. At best, DNA traces can be removed by wiping down and bleaching extremely smooth surfaces, and only if there are no crevices or similar things. Tools, paper, textiles or other objects with rough surfaces, on the other hand, are practically impossible to clean in this way, of either human, animal, or plant DNA.
- 5. DNA is an amazingly stable molecule. Therefore, it is difficult to chemically remove DNA traces, especially since sterilization (such as simple heating or alcohol) is insufficient. An option is bleach or aggressive cleaners that have sodium hypochlorite in them.
- 6. Do not use tape because it collects DNA cable ties can be used to secure materials together. To transport your materials, seal them in a garbage bag.

#### FOR ANIMALS OF THE STREET

7. Either smash it or burn it – not both. Smashing something can sometimes involve a lot of contact with the object, which risks transferring DNA traces to the object in question (especially if you have to climb onto it). Sustained fire will destroy DNA traces,

but for an object that is first smashed and then burned this is no guarantee; the parts of the object that have been touched may not be sufficiently heated by the flames to destroy all traces.

8. Wear new impermeable gloves which you've never previously touched, and put them on last once you've already changed into black bloc. This is because you want to avoid any skin, hair or sweat on the outside of the gloves, which could then be transferred to any objects you touch. Always handle tools that you are bringing with such a new pair of gloves, even if you don't plan on ditching the tools. Take care that the tools you are using, and especially the projectiles you are leaving at the site, have been free of your DNA from the beginning, and transport them carefully.

9. If you'll be using a hammer, practice breaking windows in a controlled environment before the heat of the moment. Blood is a very obvious source of DNA to even the most incompetent investigator.

10. Be careful to not have anything that can fall out during the ruckus – closed zippers are your friend. Be especially cautious when rummaging through bags or backpacks.

11. Any clothing used during the riot should not be recovered by the forensics team if it can be avoided. The days of leaving a giant heap of black hoodies in the middle of the street should come to an end – clothing will generally have DNA traces on it. Ide-

ally, you would take clothing far enough away to be able to dispose of it properly (either burn it or put it somewhere where if it is found, it won't be considered as related to the riot). A judgement call will be required when deciding whether to try to carry the clothing far away or whether to hide it somewhere on your dispersal route

12. Again, don't use tape to construct any part materials. Tape is a magnet for DNA. Rather, use plastic zip-ties to for example secure the firework to the bottle. Ideally there should be two fireworks for redundancy, to minimize the likelihood of an unexploded molotov being recovered. Traditional molotovs (using a glass bottle) need to hit a hard surface to shatter and so are unreliable when thrown inside of buildings.

WE CHARGE GENOCIDE against the United States of Amerikkka for their direct support, strategic coordination, and literal involvement in the Genocide of Palestine-in the Gaza strip, the West Bank, in South Lebanon, and throughout the Palestinian diaspora. WE CHARGE GENOCIDE AGAINST THE UNITED STATES OF AMERIKKKA and include in this definition the domestic warfare against Black, Third World, Indigenous, and other colonially oppressed peoples internal to its borders, at its borders, and beyond its borders. WE CHARGE GENOCIDE AGAINST THE UNITED STATES OF AMERIKKKA for its killing of political, cultural, spiritual leaders, organizations, communities, and social movements that resist the massively fatal gendered and racist violence of Amerikkkan empire. WE CHARGE GENOCIDE AGAINST THE UNITED STATES OF AMERIKKKA for creating a permanent state of displacement and incarceration of Indigenous peoples and lands and the chattel treatment of its human and nonhuman animal prisoners. THERE IS ONLY ONE RESPONSE TO A GENOCIDAL STATE AND THAT IS TO BURN ITS POLICING AND MILITARY INFRASTRUCTURE AND INSTITUTIONAL BASES OF VIOLENCE/DOMINANCE/POWER TO THE GROUND. TRUTH CRUSHED TO EARTH WILL RISE AGAIN.
